What is the LOC?



- ▶ A letter from Weber State University stating all General Education Requirements are fulfilled
- ► The LOC can presented to any State University or College and their GE requirements are waived, even if they are different.
- Approximately 39 college credits from both AP and CE classes

Benefits of the LOC

► For Example:

- A Student Attending Utah State University that has earned the Weber LOC
 - ▶ Waives a year and a half of college
 - Saves students over \$20,000 in tuition, fees, books and housing costs.
 - ▶ Helps prepare students for the rigors of college academics
 - Waives difficult "Freshman Weed-out" classes.
 - Students graduate from college one and a half years earlier, entering the workforce sooner, with thousands in salary gained.



Potential Pitfalls.....

- High school students taking CE classes are establishing a college GPA.
 - ► Low grades can negatively affect admissions to selective undergraduate programs or gradate schools such as:
 - ► Medical School
 - ▶ Dental School
 - ► Law School
 - ▶ Nursing
 - ▶ Business



Potential Pitfalls.....

STEM major students with the LOC may face challenges their first year in college, as some LOC classes are often used to lighten a difficult schedule.
