WHAT IS THE CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION?

- ✓ A certificate from Weber State University stating all General Education Requirements are fulfilled.
- ✓ The certificate can be presented to any State University or College (except Westminster) and their GE requirements are waived
- ✓ Approximately 39 college credits from both AP and CE classes.

WHEN IS THE CERTIFICATE COMPLETED?

Students can complete the requirements through AP and CE classes during the 9th-12th grade.

If you are interested in completing the certificate, set up a planning meeting with your counselor.

THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CERTIFICATE ARE LISTED ON THE BACK OF THIS FLYER.

BENEFITS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Saves students up to \$20,000 in tuition, fees, books, and housing costs

Helps prepare students for the rigors of college academics

Waives difficult Freshman "weed-out" classes

Students graduate from college and enter the workforce earlier

POTENTIAL PITFALLS

Students entering college must be prepared to declare a major

High school students taking CE classes are establishing a college GPA

New college students may face a challenging course load their freshman year; some of the CE classes taken for Gen. Ed. are often used to lighten a difficult class schedule
